


Executive Summary








Research Methodology








Al Adoption in Early Stages with Growing Exploration


Confident IT Spending Outlook for 2025


Infrastructure & Application Development Lead IT Priorities


Balanced Approach to IT Management with Hybrid Models

While many IT functions like Database Administration and Infrastructure Management are handled in-house, organizations are increasingly combining outsourced expertise with in-house capabilities. This hybrid approach, particularly in Cloud Security and Migration, is essential for achieving strategic goals and building a robust infrastructure.



Stable IT Outsourcing Budgets with Selective Increases

Outsourcing budgets are on the rise in key industries, with Hospitality leading the charge at 87%, followed by Manufacturing at 55% and Retail at 46%. This indicates a strong trend towards leveraging external expertise to enhance operational efficiency and drive innovation. In contrast, industries like Software and Finance show a more conservative approach.
